Auction for the benefit of FAF during the Swedish Championships in farriery and forging.

During the annual Swedish championships in farriery and forging the Swedish Farrier Association decided to donate the proceeds of their "Surprise class" to the Flying Anvil. The class is, as the name suggests, somewhat of a surprise where the competitors never know what they will be doing until the start. This year the competition focused on creative forging and 13 teams of two entered.

FAF volunteer Daniel van der Blij both arranged the competition and competed himself together with his former apprentice Pernilla Eklund. His time teaching at FAF-FID had prepared him for thinking outside of the traditional materials when forging:

«We were supposed to forge an ordinary horseshoe out of rebars, which is something I did a lot of during my time at the institute in India. We also had to make another type of shoe out of an old rasp. In other words, you really had to think an extra time on how to forge with these materials».
